

Context

Theme - Centred Interaction (TCI) has been included in the syllabus of B.Sc Psychology in Kerala University. It is an internationally accepted form of applied Humanistic Psychology, developed by the renowned psycho-analyst Ruth C Cohn. TCI entered India in 1993 and a Certificate Course in TCl has been offered by Mahatma Gandhi University and Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. But it is for first time that TCI enters the Syllabus of a course in psychology. It is in this context that an introductory webinar is organized for interested faculty members of psychology in different colleges and universities in Kerala.

Brief Profiles of the Facilitators

Matthias Scharer was Professor and Head of the Dept of Religious Pedagogy at Innsbruck University, Austria. He is a senior International TCl Facilitator of the Ruth Cohn Institute international, Berlin. He has a lot of experience of leading TCl Workshops in different countries in Europe as well as US. Matthias is author of a number of books on TCl and is currently engaged in research into Ruth Cohn's heritage along with his wife Michaela. Matthias has visited Kerala several times and led many workshops here. Once the Covid Pandemic is over, he is scheduled to lead a workshop at Sameeksha, Kalady, Ernakulam District.

Dr.C.Thomas Abraham is the first International Graduate Facilitator of TCl in India. He is currently engaged in the application of TCl for empowerment of adolescent Children ("Butterfly Effect") and for Youths and Senior Citizens. He has authored a few books in Malayalam and English on TCl
